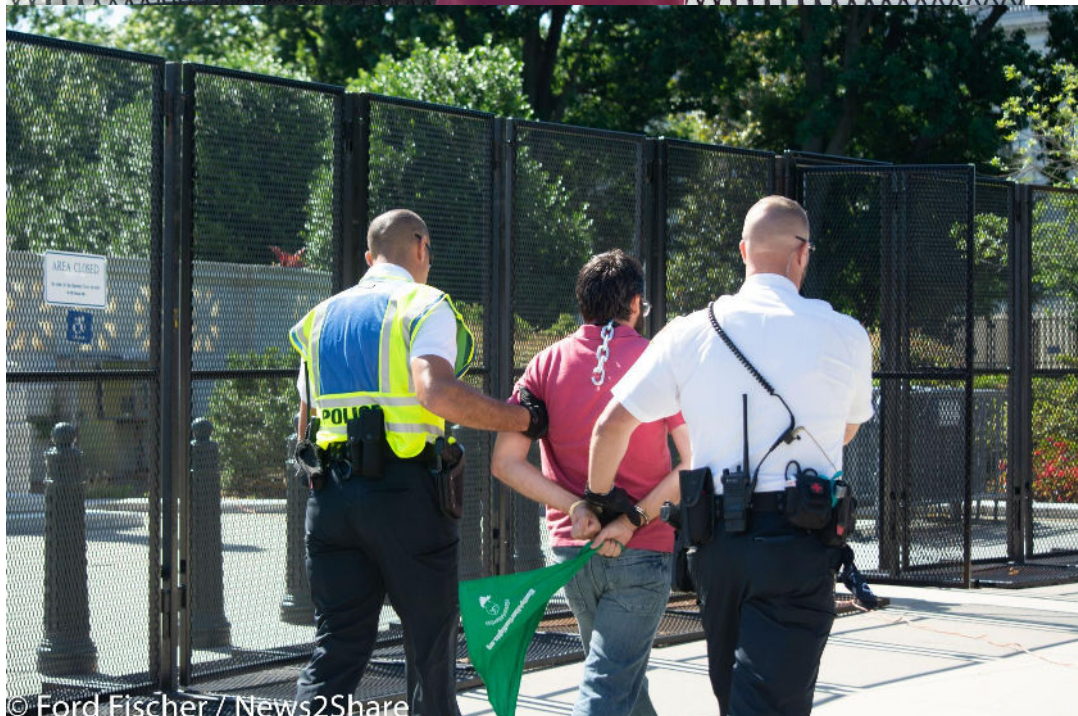


An activist stands atop the Frederick Douglass Memorial Bridge in Washington on June 24.

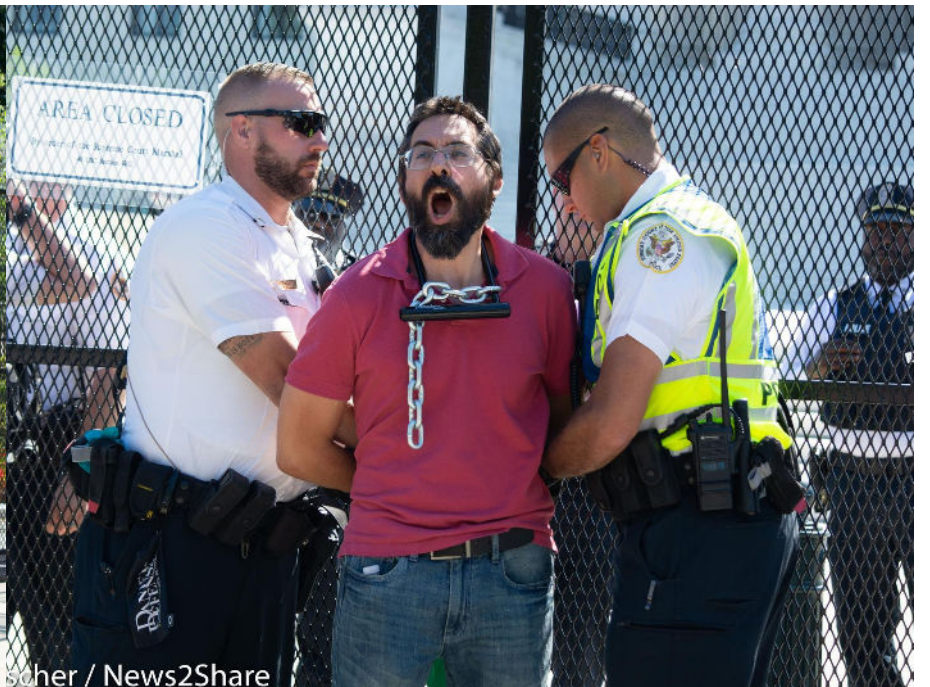

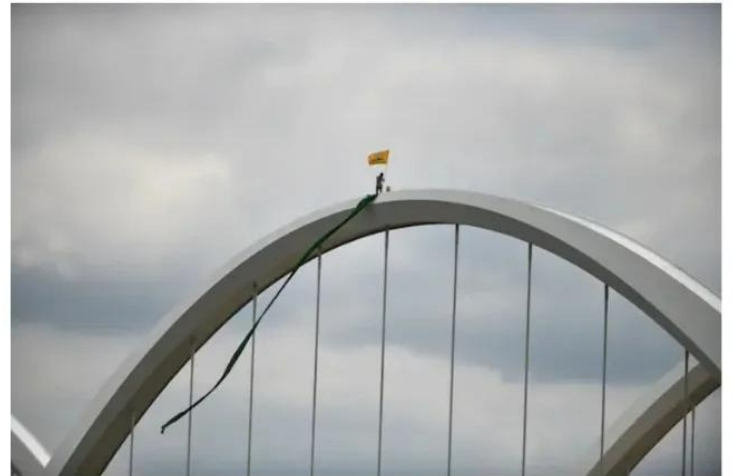
A dad climbed a bridge to protest the Supreme Court's abortion ruling
